

**Maximum Time Frame (150% Rule)**

<p><b>Undergraduate Students</b> <b>Full-time and Part-time</b></p>	<p>Students must complete their program within 150% of the program length.</p> <p>Program length = 124 credits x 150% maximum time frame = 186 attempted credits.</p> <p>(Exception: Accounting program length = 150 credits x 150% maximum time frame = 225 attempted credits.</p>	<p>Students who exceed 186 attempted credits (or 225 for accounting students) will be deemed not making satisfactory academic progress and will lose their eligibility for financial aid. Students may appeal this decision.</p>
<p><b>Graduate Students</b> <b>Full-time and Part-time</b></p>	<p>Students must complete their program within 150% of the program length.</p> <p>Adrian College requires a minimum of 30 credit hours but program length may vary depending on focus. Program length = 30 credits x 150% maximum time frame = 45 attempted credits.</p>	<p>Students who exceed the maximum time frame based on program length will be deemed not making satisfactory academic progress and will lose their eligibility for financial aid. Students may appeal this decision.</p>
